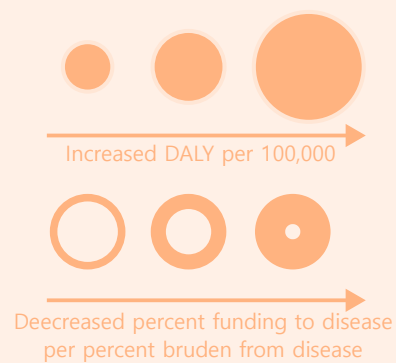
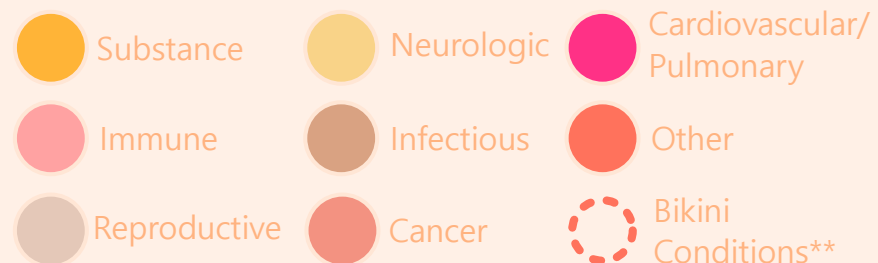


Does Bikini Medicine Cover Enough?

How does the current funding of women's health conditions address the areas causing the greatest health burdens* on women?



*Burden defined as Disability-adjusted life years (DALY) per 100,000 women, measuring the healthy years lost to disability or premature mortality.

**Bikini medicine represents an illconceived notion that women's health only differs from men's (thus only deserves specialized research) in the parts of the body covered by a bikini. Conditions labeled bikini are the conditions that fall under this notion.
